


A selection of books especially selected for children in Year 3.


If your child is a very competent reader or has read all of these titles, then try the books from the Year 4 list.

Author: Karen Owen Release Date: 05/05/2022




A Tale of Two Dragons






The Queen in the Cave






Bad Panda




Fearless: The Story of Daphne Caruana


The Stone Age Hunters, Gatherers and Woolly Mammoths

A masterclass in how to make history come to life with trademark cartoon style illustrations and lots of fascinating facts and detail.








Gobbolino the Witch's Cat






You're a Bad Man, Mr Gum!






The Bolds


